

LETTER OF INTENT FOR COOPERATION



ROYAL UNIVERSITY OF LAW AND ECONOMICS
AND

FACULTY OF LAW OF WARMADEWA UNIVERSITY

In order to promote the mutual interests between Royal University of Law and Economics and Faculty of Law, Warmadewa University (FH UNWAR), where both agree to exercise their best efforts to develop the following forms of cooperation:

- a. MoU/MoA;
- b. Joint research activities;
- c. Exchange of information, not limited to exchange of library materials but includes research publications;
- d. Exchange of Faculty members for the development of both faculties;
- e. Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students for study and research;
- f. Exchange of community services; including exchange of social-cultural activities;
- g. Invitation of authorized officials for both sides to visit and to develop cooperative mechanism between the parties; and
- h. General academic collaboration.

Both parties understand that financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds. Details for the implementation of specific projects will be mutually developed.

In the event where both parties wish to establish cooperation and collaboration programs, both parties shall enter into Memorandum of Understanding/Memorandum of Agreement which shall have a binding effect on both parties.
